WORSHIP (10 minutes)

- Have someone read aloud clearly **Romans 8:1-11**

- Have a few people lead out in prayers of praise to Jesus for setting us free!

WIN (15 minutes)

WORD (25 minutes)

1. Have different people take turns reading until you’ve read **1 Corinthians 5:1-13**. What are your initial thoughts of the many serious things Paul says in this chapter?
2. True love is not equivalent to tolerance! How do you walk the balance between accepting people and yet taking a stand against sin?
3. Have someone read **v. 5** again. How do you think turning someone over to Satan result in their salvation on the Day of the Lord?
4. Have someone re-read **vs. 9-13**. Why does Paul set forth one standard for relating to people in the church who are living in sin and another for non-believers?
5. **(Bonus – If time!)** For most of Christian history the Christians have tended to be more concerned with judging those outside the church than evaluating their own behavior and motives. What is the result of this?

WORKS (25 minutes)

- Break into **2 or 3’s of the same gender**
- Have someone read aloud **James 5:16** and **Proverbs 28:13**.
- Make your time of sharing honest and vulnerable!. Then pray for each other!
