- Submission of a new application for the year your child would be entering school
- Pre-Admissions Testing
- A reference from the church you regularly attend
- A teacher reference for students entering grades 6 – 12
- An interview with the school principal

ENROLLMENT FEE: An enrollment fee of \$100 PER STUDENT must accompany enrollment form. (The enrollment fee is **non-refundable** unless space is unavailable for the placement of the applicant.)

TUITION POLICY:

We understand that tuition and other fees are necessary in order for Christian Academy to successfully fulfill its mission. We commit ourselves to promptly meet our financial obligations as indicated by our signature below in accordance with Biblical stewardship. We also understand and agree to comply with the following tuition policies:

- ❖ Tuition is due on the first day of each week in which your child is scheduled to attend. A weekly late charge of \$10 will be added to your fee if payment is not received as scheduled.
- ❖ A two-week written notice must be given for any withdrawals prior to the end of the school year because the hiring of teachers and staff and the ordering of classroom materials are based upon anticipated enrollment.
- ❖ Tuition that becomes **two weeks past due** will subject the student to being withheld from attending school.
- ❖ An after-hour fee of \$1.00/minute per student will be charged beginning at 6:01 p.m. for Full-Day classes and at 11:46 a.m. for Half-Day classes.
- ❖ A \$25 returned check fee will be charged on all returned checks.
