ADMISSION CRITERIA REQUIRED FOR KINDERGARTEN

The following admission criteria are required for all Kindergarten applicants:

- Submission of a new application for the year your child would be entering Kindergarten
- Pre-Admissions Testing
- A reference from the church you regularly attend
- A parent interview with the school principal

Tuition Policy

TUITION RATES AND FEES: See accompanying tuition rate and fee schedule for specific campus information.

ENROLLMENT FEE: An enrollment fee of \$100 PER STUDENT must accompany enrollment form. (The enrollment fee is **non-refundable** unless space is unavailable for the placement of the applicant.) This is required for all new students.

TUITION POLICY:

We understand that tuition and other fees are necessary in order for Christian Academy to successfully fulfill its mission. We commit ourselves to promptly meet our financial obligations as indicated by our signature below in accordance with Biblical stewardship. We also understand and agree to comply with the following tuition policies:

- Tuition is due on the first day of each week in which your child is scheduled to attend. A weekly late charge of \$10 will be added to your fee if payment is not received as scheduled.
- A two-week written notice must be given for any withdrawals prior to the end of the school year because the hiring of teachers and staff and the ordering of classroom materials are based upon anticipated enrollment. Tuition must be paid during the two-week notice period, during which child may attend.
- Tuition that becomes **two weeks past due** will subject the student to being withheld from attending school.
- Because tuition is calculated on an annual basis, adjustments will not be made for unscheduled closures or absences.
- An after-hour fee of \$1.00/minute per student will be charged beginning at 6:01 p.m. for Full-Day classes and at 11:46 a.m. for Half-Day classes.
- A \$25 returned check fee will be charged on all returned checks.
- Please see Schedule of Tuition and Fees for additional information regarding tuition policy, holiday/vacation policies, and additional fees. The 2012-2013 Schedule of Tuition and Fees will be available in January, 2013.
