

Tuition Policy

Please understand that tuition and other fees are necessary in order for Christian Academy to successfully fulfill its mission. By signature below you commit to promptly meet financial obligations in accordance with Biblical stewardship, and that you understand and agree to comply with the following tuition policy:

- ❖ The application fee is non-refundable unless the school is unable to place your student. Withdrawals after June 1, 2010, but prior to the start of school, are subject to the following financial obligation: After June 1, 2010 - one-month tuition is due; after July 1, 2010- two-months tuition is due; and after August 1, 2010 and prior to the beginning of school - three-months tuition is due.
- ❖ One year's tuition is due if a student withdraws after the beginning of the school year because the hiring of teachers and staff and the ordering of textbooks and other classroom materials are based upon anticipated enrollment. Parents will be expected to honor their full year's commitment to the school. Requests for exceptions must be addressed to the Assistant Superintendent of Finance, in writing, and will only be considered in extreme circumstances such as the death of a parent, loss of employment, or moving from the area.
- ❖ Tuition that becomes **two months past due** will subject the student to being withheld from attending school until such amounts due to Christian Academy are made current.
- ❖ Monthly tuition payments are made, via electronic bank transfer, to FACTS Tuition Management. The fee for this service is \$38 for the 2010-11 school year.

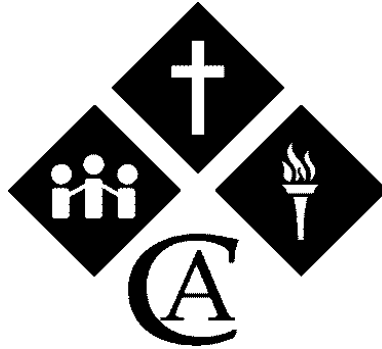
Start Planning For Kindergarten
