NEW STUDENTS:

Application Fee - A **non-refundable** fee of \$100 per student must accompany each application.

Enrollment Fee - When your student is accepted to Christian Academy, a **non-refundable** enrollment fee will be collected to confirm your child's placement:

- New Families - \$300 per student
- Current Families - \$200 per student

RETURNING STUDENTS:

Reenrollment Fee - A **non-refundable** fee of \$200 per student is due **January 29, 2010**. This fee will be paid in conjunction with the online reenrollment process.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition assistance awards are based on the family's demonstrated need as determined by a third-party agency that makes financial needs assessments for private and Christian schools. Each award is made for one year only, based on the availability of tuition assistance funds.

TUITION POLICY

We understand that tuition and other fees are necessary in order for Christian Academy to successfully fulfill its mission. We commit ourselves to promptly meet our financial obligations in accordance with Biblical stewardship. We also understand and agree to comply with the following tuition policy:

- Withdrawals after June 1 but prior to the start of school are subject to the following financial obligation: After June 1 – one-month's tuition is due, after July 1 – two-months' tuition is due, and after August 1 and prior to beginning of school – three-months' tuition is due.
- One year's tuition is due if a student withdraws after the beginning of the school year because the hiring of teachers and staff and the ordering of textbooks and other classroom materials are based upon anticipated enrollment. Student records will not be released until the account is paid in full. Parents will be expected to honor their full year's commitment to the school. Requests for exceptions must be addressed to the Chief Financial Officer, in writing, and will only be considered in extreme circumstances (such as death of a parent).
- Tuition that becomes **two months past due** will subject the student to being withheld from attending school until such amounts due to CAL are made current.
- Monthly tuition payments are made, via electronic bank transfer, to FACTS Tuition Management. The annual fee is \$38 per family.

ADDITIONAL FEES

- **Senior Class Fees** **\$175** for high school **seniors** only. This fee covers the cost of diplomas, diploma covers, and other expenses of the graduation programs. In addition, it covers the yearbook and video.
- **High School/ Middle School Athletic Fee** Athletic participation fees are **\$125** for each sport in which the student participates. There may be additional uniform and team fees that vary from sport to sport.
- **Food Service** The cost of daily lunch for the 2009-2010 school year was **\$3.00**. Ala carte food items for middle and high school students vary in cost. However, increases in the wholesale cost of food and supplies to our kitchen periodically necessitate a corresponding increase in the price of the lunch. Parents are encouraged to deposit money into their student's debit account in the cafeteria to expedite the speed of the serving line.
- **Miscellaneous Expenses** During the course of the school year other expenses are involved for various services or activities, such as intramural sports, orchestra/choral participation, elective class fees (Home Ec, Art, Missions, Advanced Placement), school picture packages, yearbooks, class functions, athletic events, parking permits, music programs and plays. **Most of these expenses are optional.** The school makes every effort to keep these expenses to a minimum.
- **Returned Check Fee** Christian Academy will charge a **\$25** returned check fee for all returned checks.
