As current research reveals, early childhood is the most important time of development in the life of young children. The goal of the English Station Junior Academy is to stimulate each child's physical, mental, emotional and social development while maintaining a strong spiritual emphasis.

The philosophy of our Scripture-based curriculum is that young children learn best by doing. With the understanding that play is their "work," a balance of child-initiated and teacher-directed activities help to prepare the children for future academic growth and development.

Program Highlights

We seek to provide a loving, Christian environment by Christian teachers who celebrate the individuality of each child and recognizes each as a precious gift created by God.

All programs are in preparation for Kindergarten with special emphases on phonics, math, music and handwriting, and the weekly chapel service is centered around the weekly Bible story. We also offer enrichment classes in music, PE, computer, Spanish and library.

There are many opportunities for family involvement and participation with an active Parent Teacher Organization.

Program Certification

The English Station Junior Academy is a member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and is licensed by the State of Kentucky. We also ensure that every classroom is staffed by a teacher who has earned a Bachelor's Degree.

4-Year-Old Program

The 4-Year-Old Preschool Program introduces students to the basics of a Kindergarten readiness program.

The full-day Preschool program is available for students, Monday-Friday, from 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. The "school day" hours are 8:15 a.m.-3:30 p.m. with an extended program 3:30-6:00 p.m. for no additional cost.

We also offer a half-day Preschool program for a limited number of students, Monday-Friday, 8:15-11:30 a.m.

3-Year-Old Program

Students must be 3-years-old by August 1 of the academic school year, and completely toilet trained in order to be accepted into the program.

The 3-Year-Old Program is intended to introduce little ones to a classroom environment and social development as they grow and mature.
