Current research reveals that early childhood is a very important time of development in the life of a child. The goal of the Christian Academy of Indiana Junior Academy is to stimulate each child's physical, mental, emotional and social development while maintaining a strong spiritual emphasis.

The philosophy of our Scripture-based curriculum is that young children learn best by doing. With the understanding that play is their "work," a balance of child-initiated and teacher-directed activities help to prepare children for future academic growth and development.

### *Program Highlights*

Teachers seek to provide a loving, Christian environment by Christian teachers that celebrates the individuality of each child and recognizes each as a precious gift created by God.

All programs are in preparation for Kindergarten with emphasis on phonemic awareness, phonics, math, music and handwriting. Weekly chapel services are centered around the weekly Bible story. Enrichment classes are offered in music and library.

There are many opportunities for family involvement and participation with an active Parent Teacher Organization.
